5. Boarding state sanctions have been obtained for New York, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey.
6. We very seldom make changes because of weather **BUT** coaches are responsible for checking the web site the day of the meet to be sure the meet is on as scheduled.

7. List number of entrants in each event. Seeding will be done by the card method on the day of the meet. Cards will be provided. You **MAY NOT** use your own cards. Please use seed times for the events listed. Make conversions as necessary.
8. **Unlimited entry in all events.** (except varsity relays)
9. Please bring safety pins and batons. They will not be supplied.
10. No starting blocks in this meet.
11. No spikes are allowed at Rockland Community College Field House.
12. Depending upon the number of entries, the 6 jump rule may be used in PV and HJ and/or the opening heights may be changed. In an attempt to meet the needs of both the novice and the elite jumper/vaulter if the 6 jump rule is used the meet directors reserve the right to eliminate the six jump rule when a few elite jumpers/vaulters remain. Also, the meet directors reserve the right to lower the bar during the competition for an athlete delayed by another event.
13. There will be a refreshment and food stand.
14. **DIRECTIONS TO ROCKLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE:** Take the NYS Thruway to Airmont Road. Follow Airmont Road north to College Road. Make a left onto College Road and proceed 1/2 mile to college and field house in on the left.
15. There will be finals in the varsity shot, long jump, and triple jump. Novice and Frosh in these events will have three attempts only.

Shot Put : Girls Frosh, Novice, and Varsity will throw first. Boys to follow. If entry warrants a 2nd circle will be added for the boys and they will start around 5pm.

High Jump: Girls Jump first: Frosh, Novice, Varsity together: Girls open at 4', 4'3", & 4'6". Then Boys Jump: Frosh, Novice, Varsity together: Boys open at 4'6", 4'9" & 5'3".

Pole Vault: Frosh Boys open at 7', Girls open at 8', and Varsity Boys open at 10'

Long Jump/Triple Jump: we will have **Two** pits.

Pit 1:

Girls Varsity LJ – 3 jumps – no finals, then Boys Varsity LJ – 3 jumps no finals, then Frosh Boys & Girls LJ – 3 jumps.

Pit 2:

Boys Varsity TJ – 3 jumps – no finals, then Girls Varsity TJ – 3 jumps no finals, then Frosh Boys & Girls TJ – 3 jumps.
