Ridgewood girls take indoor title

SUFFERN, N.Y. — The Ridgewood Winter Games was the final local indoor track meet of the season and the Maroons made the most of it, capturing the girls team title with 45 points Friday at the Rockland Community College field house. Lakewood topped the boys and Bergen Catholic finished a close second.

"We were real pleased with the number of schools that entered this late in the season," Ridgewood spring track coach Jacob Brown said. "Usually, there's nothing left for freshmen and sophomores and non-top varsity runners. This was good for them and track."

Jennifer McDermott paced the Maroons in two events, capturing the triple and long jumps. Jennifer Hughes was third in the 1,000-meter run and second in the mile. Hughes finished two places behind teammate Lynn Collazo in the 1,000. Collazo ran the distance in 2:17.9, Hughes in 2:35.7.

Tammy Rayvich won the shot put with a distance of 34 feet, 2½ inches and Alfreda Eldridge finished third with a toss of 31½. Kerri Reilly placed second in the 300-yard dash and Ginny Figlar outran the field in the 600. Lynn Degelmann finished fourth in the

event.

With spring sports on the way, many athletes are beginning to feel the stress of competing through fall and winter. One of the more durable performers, however, is Sara Pieri of Ramapo. The senior captured the 60-yard dash in 7.2 seconds and finished eighth in the long jump.

"It's a long season for many of these runners because they run six days a week and some even on Sundays," Ramapo coach Joe Buesing said. "She [Pieri] runs cross-country and indoor, and then with academics it can be tough on a kid. I give her credit. Another week and a half and we start outdoors. It takes a special type of kid to do this."

Rob Ghelli of Bergen Catholic also is feeling the effects. He finished second in the triple and long jumps and third in the 60-yard hurdle. "You can feel it in your legs after four events," he said. "I usually get better at the end of the season."

Paramus Catholic also fared well, finishing fourth behind Cardinal Spellman of New York. Mark Bednarz captured the 600-yard dash in 1:16.1. John Lauria completed the two-mile run in 9:53.6 and placed third.
