Ridgewood Games benefit stars

NANUET — The Ridgewood Winter Games proved an interesting warmup, tuneup, and wrapup for many of the top local track and field athletes Thursday.

For Pascack Valley's Jen Metz, her come-from-behind victory in the 600-yard run over highly regarded sophomore Tiffany Weatherford of Newark Science set the stage for her Vitalis Invitational 1,000-meter performance Friday night at the Meadowlands.

For Eric Boucher of Ridgewood, J.R. Meloro of Bergen Catholic, and Ken Flynn of Ramsey, the meet served as a final tuneup before the New Jersey State Meet of Champions Feb. 18.

Metz battled Weatherford, the state's top sprinter last spring, and finally passed her in the final 75 yards on the new Rockland Community College surface, winning by 10 yards in 1:28.3.

"When she stopped my first

move, I just thought I'd try another one," said Metz. "My teammates have been telling me that I've just got to reach deeper and this time I found something extra."

For Boucher and Flynn, the something extra included a meet record in the 1,600 and 3,200, respectively.

Boucher and Meloro dueled brilliantly for most of the race's final two laps with the Ridgewood star holding off his longtime rival in a seasonal best of 4:24.4. That was 1.6 seconds faster than the meet record set last year by Ernesto Perez of West Side.

Meloro ran a personal best of 4:24.8 and State Group 3 champion Moses Mekbeb of Cliffside Park had an indoor personal best of 4:27.8 for third place.

The two figure to be among the top finishers in the Meet of Cham-

pions 1,600, with Meloro also competing in the 3,200. Neither will compete in the Bergen County championships Feb. 17.

Flynn also will skip the Bergen meet to try and win the State indoor 3,200 title that eluded him last winter.

Thursday, he ran an outstanding race against a good field, taking more than 15 seconds off the 3,200 record by running 9:31.0 to win by more than 50 meters over Group 1 champion Larry Weiss of Metuchen. Flynn also finished fourth in the 1000.

Willie Best of Hackensack prefers a busy schedule, so he is expected to run in the Bergen meet, even though he qualified in the 400, 800, and long jump in the State Group 4 meet. Thursday, he had a thrilling finish to steal a race that New Yorker Brendan Mulcahey of St. Francis Prep figured he had won.

Best sizzled through the final 125 yards in 13.5 to win the 1,000 yards in a meet record 2:18.5.
