Simmons, Davi remain undefeated

SUFFERN, N.Y. — At most indoor track meets, the sprint and hurdles races are held at the same time on opposite sides of the track before the rest of the meet starts. As a result, many times the finals are held and champions are crowned before very many notice.

But if Ernest Simmons of Englewood and Veronica Davi of Immaculate Heart Academy continue their winning ways, everyone will stop to watch.

Simmons and Davi remained undefeated in the boys dash and girls hurdles, respectively, Monday night at the Ridgewood Winter Games II meet in the Rockland Community College Field House.

Simmons ran the 55-meter dash in 6.6 seconds and added places in the 300 yards, long jump, and triple jump.

"I guess people haven't seen how well I'm doing," said Simmons, who moved to Englewood from West Palm Beach, Fla., last winter. "Coach [Reggie] Williams and [Terry] Amos have been working with me on the starts and I'm doing a lot better in the 55 than I thought I would be."

For Davi, an easy winner in the high hurdles, in 8.6, success will also be measured by how she does in the spring when she tries to improve on last year's second-place State Meet of Champions finish in the 400 intermediate hurdles.

"I'm trying to build up my endurance for the intermediates," said Davi, who came back and finished second in the 1,000-yard run after her win in the high hurdles. Rob Reeder of Northern Highlands celebrated his selection to next Friday's Millrose Games mile by setting a meet record in the 3,200 in 9:29.7, while Fair Lawn's Matt Psaltis tied the meet record of 13-6 in the vault and just missed a Bergen County record at 14-1.

As usual, Darius Pemberton tripled, in the hurdles, long jump, and triple jump, leaping 23 feet, 2¼ inches in the long jump. Other North Jersey winners included Courtney Davis of Hackensack (1,000 yards), Chris Langan of Don Bosco (1,600 meters), the Bergen Catholic 1,600 relay team and Ridgewood's 3,200 relay team.

Pascack Valley's Jennifer Metz of Pascack Valley dominated the 300- and 600-yard runs and now has winter titles in eight different events from 55 meters to a mile this winter. Passaic Valley star Michele Dudzinski set a meet record by clearing 5-6 in the high jump for the second time in three days. Eileen Fitzgerald of Ridgewood won impressively in both the 1,600 and 3,200 meters. Teri Martin of Hackensack won the long jump and Ridgewood took the 1,600 relay.
