Athletes achieve personal records

HACKENSACK — The Bergen County relays were Thursday night and the State championships start today. And the Northern New Jersey Interscholastic League championships are Monday. So the fields at the rescheduled Ridgewood Winter Games 1 were much smaller than they could have been, and many of the area's top athletes were missing.

But for Ebony Knighton of Passaic Tech and Jen Mechlowe of Pascack Valley, the memories of Friday night's meet will linger for a long time.

Both athletes won their first major meet and their performances stamp them as solid runners to watch in the future.

Knighton, a sophomore, outdueled junior teammate Tiana Robinson to win the 55 meters in a personal best of 7.6 seconds.

Passaic Tech sprint coach Johnny Moore — who also coaches in the summer with the New Birth Track Club, which has produced such stars as two-time State champ Nicole Carmichael, now at Ohio State, and Passaic champ Tiamecua Fulton of Eastside — thinks the two PCT performers have great potential.

"We use [Carmichael and Fulton] in our comments in practice and to get them motivated," Moore said. "It gives them reasons to try and get better each day."

"We like running against each other," Knighton said. "It's great to have someone to practice with

like this. I've worked out with Nicole a few times and I really admire her."

PV's Jen Mechlowe is also chasing a legend, former State 800-meter champion Jennifer Metz, now a junior at the University of Wisconsin.

Mechlowe, who took four seconds off her personal best time in running 1:50.2 to win the 600, talked about Metz, who holds all of PV's middle distance records.

"She makes me go faster because I know if she could have run so fast, it's possible for me to run faster," said Mechlowe, a junior. "My gym teacher in eighth grade convinced me to go out for track."

The absence of stars like Caitlin Wittreich of Tenafly, Vicki Byrne of Saddle Brook, Stephanie Doyle of Ridgewood, and Kourtney Gallo of Immaculate Heart didn't bother Mechlowe.

"I didn't recognize anyone on the starting line," Mechlowe said. "It made me think I had a chance to win. I'm very excited to win a gold, and even more excited to improve so much in my time. Now I'm really looking forward to my next race at states."

Other area winners Friday included Neville Rose of Kennedy (high hurdles), Kadrian Belgin of Kennedy (600), Jeremy D'Errico of Clifton (1,600) among the boys and Holly Garrison of Dumont (high hurdles) and Sabrina Nealy of Kennedy (1,600) for the girls.
