Sedo takes fourth; Fraser leads Passaic

RIDGEWOOD — Ridgewood junior Celeste Sedo was taking her PSATs on Saturday morning while listening to the wind and rain whip about.

A few hours later, Sedo and other crosscountry runners would be slogging through the mud at Veterans Field in the

Ridgewood Invitational.

Despite the hard, driving rain and overall miserable conditions, Sedo finished fourth overall and third in the girls Varsity B bracket in 20 minutes, 42 seconds, tops among Bergen County girls. Lodi's Luis Duarte was the top male finisher in boys Varsity B, placing seventh in 18:07.

Washingtonville, N.Y., swept the boys and girls Varsity B races with Ridgewood placing third in both. St. John Vianney won the girls Varsity A race with 59 points, while Dumont was third with 80. Jefferson Township took the boys Varsity A division and Dumont finished fifth.

"We looked carefully at the weather and the reports called for it to get worse after 3 p.m., so we thought we'd push it up," Ridgewood coach Jacob Brown said.

Ridgewood senior Kate Cohn ran 21:31 to finish 10th, and classmate Carrie Ruggles was 13th in 21:45. Will Byrne was the top Ridgewood runner, posting a 19:01 to finish 15th.

Puddles lined the 3.1-mile course from the grass to the blacktop, which left runners caked in mud.

"At last year's State sectionals at Darlington it was like hurricane conditions, but these are the worst conditions," Sedo

said. "When I got here I didn't see the course, but when I was warming up I heard runners talking about how bad it was. I didn't know what to expect."

Duarte went one step farther.

"There was a lot of mud," he said. "I was falling into it. It was coming up to my ankles. I felt like I was carrying extra pounds each time."

Each runner had his or her tribulations. "I was sinking in the mud and then I fell toward the end of the race in the forest," Sedo said. "I was in shock that I fell."

Duarte took a wrong turn late in race,

but recovered quickly.

"I wear glasses, but not during the race, and I couldn't see how far ahead of me the guy was," he said. "The course was confusing. Everyone was having problems, especially in the beginning."

Dumont's Mary Thomas finished ninth in girls Varsity A in 22:28, with 11th place claimed by teammate Helena Brady

(22:48).

Dana Brintz of Immaculate Heart Academy ran 21:28 to place ninth in girls Varsity B.

Fraser leads Passaic

Bernard Fraser ran 17:22, leading Passaic to the William Paterson Invitational championship. Juan Martinez placed fourth, Rudy Ulhoa was eighth, and Natesh Patel ninth for Passaic. Greg Beck of Parsippany was second in 17:24.
