RIDGEWOOD — No local team scored victories Saturday in the 25th annual Ridgewood Invitational at Veterans Field, but the Ridgewood boys and girls and Paramus Catholic boys had good performances in a tuneup for Saturday's Bergen County championships.

The Ridgewood boys, led by the 3-8-9 finishes of Tim McDonagh, Mike Martin, and Dan Oros, were a very strong second behind New York state powerhouse Washingtonville, 36-63, in the large school B race. The Maroons defeated New Jersey state-ranked Middletown North and Group 4 sectional contender Memorial.

Manuel Thomas of Washingtonville won the race in 16 minutes, 24.7 seconds. Eastside junior Owen Tonkins was fourth.

Lawrenceville School took four of the top 10 places in the small school A race, but Paramus Catholic also ran well for second, 46-79.

James Milon of PC was seventh, a minute behind Mike St. Lawrence of Goshen. Teammate Matt Marovich was 12th as PC placed its top five in the top 25.

Ridgewood's girls finished behind Warwick Valley (N.Y.) and Red Bank Catholic, 49-65-73, but led by Meg McDermott placed their top five runners within 29 seconds from 10th to 19th places.

Jessica Van Denend of Eastern Christian was eighth in the girls A race in 21:38.

## William Paterson Invitational

WAYNE — Natalie Popowicz of Clifton outran Kim Pereira of Parsippany by 40 meters to lead the Mustangs to an impressive victory at the William Paterson Invitational on Saturday.

Popowicz led a 1-3-4-6-8 finish as Clifton defeated Verona, 16-58, for the team title, by running 21:21 for the 5,000-meter race. Teammates Edith Werpachowski (third), Tracey Cook (fourth), Kristin Rumbaugh (sixth), and Pia Guinto (eighth) all finished in the top 10 in a tuneup for Friday's Passaic County championships.

Elizabeth, led by Feder Estelus, who set a course record of 17:04, defeated Clifton, 45-85, in the boys race. Clifton was led by Marcin Stanislawski, who was fourth in 17:51.8.

Miller finished 15 seconds ahead of runner-up Rolando Ortiz of St. Peter's on Staten Island. Bill Mason of Cinnaminson was third in 13:02.

Miller has been on a tremendous roll this month. Two weeks ago, he placed third behind All-Staters Murad Campbell of Overbrook and Jon Fasulo of Hunterdon Central in the A Division of the Shore Coaches Invitational at hilly Holmdel Park. Miller's time of 16:03 was the third fastest of the day. Last Saturday, Miller won the Hartford Invitational in Churchville, Md., in 16:22, the fifth-best time ever on the course.

"I've been feeling pretty good lately," said Miller, who puts Princeton atop his list of college possibili-

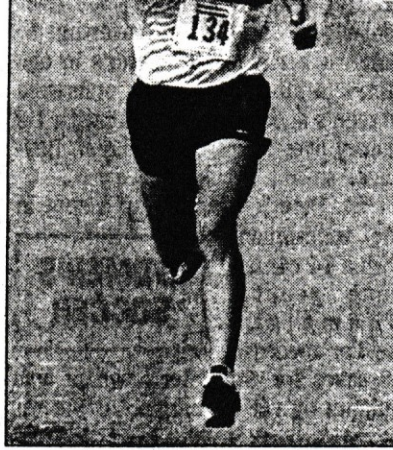

Running well at Van Cortlandt was very important for Miller, who hopes to run there Nov. 28 — over 3.1 miles — in the Foot Locker Northeast Regional championships. The top eight finishers in that race qualify for the National Championships on Dec.
