Garrett jumping back strong

SUFFERN, N.Y. — As a freshman, Saddle Brook's Nick Garrett appeared on his way to being Bergen County's next great long and triple jumper. He won the freshman 1-2 championship in both and was a fine hurdler as well.

He took another step forward last winter, earning a pair of medals at the Ridgewood Winter Games 2 meet in his two best events, and leaping more than 42 feet as a sophomore.

Then trouble struck in the form of a deep pulled muscle in his buttocks, cutting short his indoor season and wiping

out his outdoor sophomore season.

But Garrett has come all the way back as Wednesday's double win at this year's Ridgewood Winter Games 2 proved, and if he can remain healthy some of the promise he showed as a freshman will come to fruition in his junior year.

"It was hard to miss so much time last year because I really like to do track and field and I had had such a good indoor season," said Garrett, who defeated Passaic champion Tyrone Johnson of Kennedy in the long and triple jumps Wednesday. "This year when I came back I knew

I had to pace myself and not do too much or I'd get hurt again. The injury was constantly in my mind."

With the help of coach Howie Schuman, who has not yet pushed the talented Garrett to his limits, Garrett has pushed the injury to the back of his mind.

He had career highs of 21-10 in the long jump and 44-34 in the triple Wednesday in the Rockland Community College pits.

"The triple jump is my favorite event because there's so much technique involved," Garrett said. "If you can master the technique there's no telling how far you can go."

There's no question Garrett can go much further. His 44-foot jump, the best in the state this year, came despite losing up to two feet of distance by not being on the board.

Garrett was not the only successful Bergen athlete in the 70-school, multistate meet.

Local athletes won both high jumps and 1,600-meter races, and Ridgewood's Helena LaMothe joined Garrett by winning the girls triple jump with a leap of 33-3.

Nicole Brown of Teaneck entered her name in what is becoming the area's glamour event, the girls high jump, leaping 5-2 to edge Lauren Flynn of Suffern and Emily Branch of Toms River East on fewer misses. She became the sixth area jumper to surpass 5-2 this winter, a height only one jumper cleared three years ago.

"I need to keep on training if I'm going to keep improving," said Brown. "There's a lot of competition around and I can't afford an injury like the tendinitis I had in my right leg if I'm going to be able keep up."

All-American Cheryl Burdick of Ramsey has cleared 5-8 this winter and Jamie Lilien of Pascack Valley and Mary Jones and Bridgette Atkinson of Hackensack have made 5-4.

Ramapo's Eric Knackmuhs came from seventh place at the halfway point to win the 1,600-meter run in 4:38.2, a day after his impressive upset of Corey Kunz in the North Jersey Invitational 1,000, and Julie Clifford of Holy Angels barely broke a sweat in a routine 5:34.2 win in the girls 1,600.
