Mighty good, getting better

ENGLEWOOD - Hackensack's Monique Mighty has some lofty goals. And despite getting off to what she called a slow start, she's now beginning to pick up steam, and that's bad news for the competition.

The junior again stood out in the discus and shot put at the 10th annual Englewood Relays on Saturday.

Mighty and Shaniek Easley gave Hackensack a gold medal in the discus with a total of 205-6 and followed that up with a bronze-medal performance of 64-6 in the shot put. Mighty's individual marks were 109 feet and 33 feet, respectively.

Contrary to what Mighty may have felt after the meet, she again showed the field that she's more than capable of repeating last season's feats.

The returning State champion in the discus, Mighty is just beginning to feel like the force that shredded the competition last year.

"This season I feel like I got off to a slow start," she said. "It was the same last season when I started off with early throws of 79 and 80 feet [in the discus]. This year I was starting off with [throws of] 109 feet. But now I

feel like I'm gaining a foot at every meet."

Despite being the favorite each week, she doesn't feel extra pressure. And her coaches won't let her get complacent.

"Everyone expects a lot from me. I mean there is pressure, but it's just within me, not from anyone else," she said. "I owe a lot to my coaches, like coach [Ed] Church, [Darren] Resska, and [Kelly] LaPietra. They've been great."

Before the season is over, Mighty wants to reach 140 feet in the discus. And at her current pace, she feels like it isn't too far off.

Not only does Mighty see herself refining her skills and distance in the discus, she also has a goal in the shot

"I'm really trying to reach 36 feet in the shot put," she said after her third place finish in the event. "My personal record is 34-10, so it's not that far away."

And for those who doubt this talented junior, she gladly accepts all challengers.
