Paramus junior jumps at chance to set bar high

SUFFERN, N.Y. - Paramus junior Jessica Malacrida has been involved in track and field for almost half her life.

"I started high jumping and running track in the fifth grade because we have a good recreation program in Paramus," she said. "My sister [Kristen] was a shot-putter, so I tried it once, but it was clear that she was the shot-putter in the family. So I switched to high jumping and really loved it."

Malacrida won her specialty with a clearance of 5 feet Tuesday night at the Ridgewood Winter Games 2 at a cold Rockland Community College Field House. Then she continued to show she's also one of North Jersey's top hurdlers by winning the 55-meter hurdles in a personal-best 8.7 seconds, becoming one of only three multi-event winners at the meet. Her overall development pleases coach Jeff Schorling.

"All I told her in the beginning of the season was that now she was a junior and she knows how to high jump and she knows how to hurdle," said Schorling, "and it was time for her to get more aggressive in her events and do what she knows she needs to do to

get better and more consistent. And so far she's doing it."

Last week, Malacrida cleared 5-5 in the high jump, becoming just the fifth girl in Bergen County history to make that height, in winning the second of three Garfield Invitational meets.

"I was thrilled by that even though I thought they had put the bar at 5-6," said Malacrida. "But the official said he had put at 5-5 so I could set the [meet] record, and that was a great thrill.

"My coaches have been so great to me ever since I started doing the sport, and now I'm getting some help from [former State indoor champion] Janet Andrews over at River Dell in the high jump, and it's made me even more confident in my jumping," said Malacrida.

"And now I've really gotten better in the hurdles and that's exciting too, because I get to compete against someone like [Teaneck's] Michelle Smith, who's so good at it."

Malacrida is a sweeper on the Spartans girls soccer team that went 11-8-1 last year. But she knows her athletic future in college is in track.
