
Remember: August 2,9,16,23,&30. at 7:00 pm.

WEST PATERSON—Howie Schuman and Lou Molino got their wishes yesterday, as Saddle Brook and Ramsey took group championships in the girls cross-country North Jersey 1 Sectional championships at Garret Mountain.

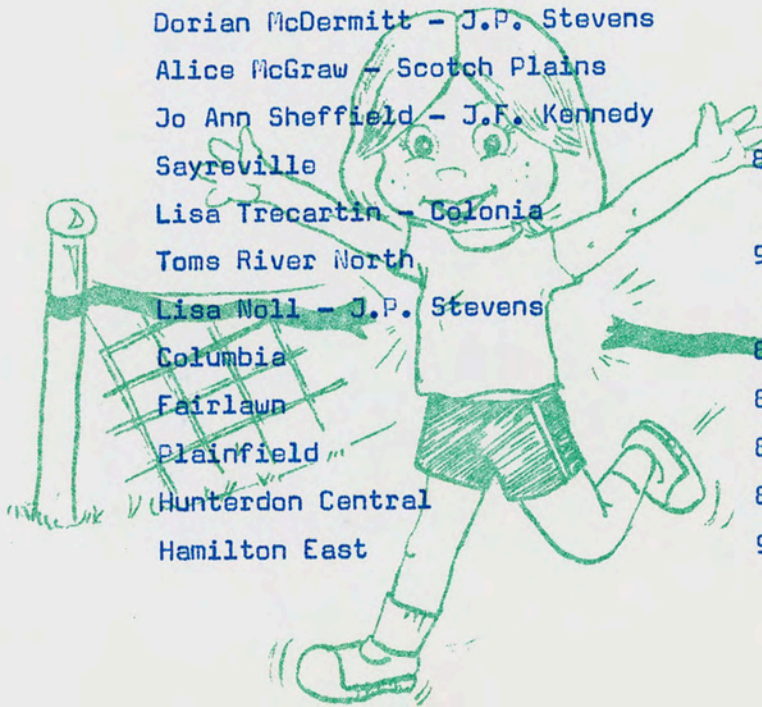

I've always believed that no segment of our society has a bigger heart than sports people, and the way the area has responded to the John Deputy Fund supports that belief . . . John, the young and well-liked Ramsey High teacher and football coach, died of a mysterious illness— leaving a wife and two young boys . . . But Jim says he is hopeful that more contributions will be received. . . Checks can be made out to the John DePuyt Fund and sent to Robertson at the high school. . . The cause of DePuyt's death was never determined, with test still being conducted in various parts of the country in search of the illness that took his life at a young age.

Kevin Kennedy, Ramapo College's hockey and golf standout, was one of the athletes who got the ice sport started on a club basu at Ramapo High School a few years back. . .
