Ridgewood also took first in the NNJIL girls meet, matching the boys with five runners finishing among the top 10 in the field. Bergenfield was a distant second.

The Maroons ran 1-2 in individual times with Mary Ellen Mileski's 21:25 beating out teammate Carol Dickstein's 21:28. Cathy Duffy ran fifth, Barbara Remmers seventh, and Coleen Wright eighth for Ridgewood.

Glassboro triumphs

HOLMDEL — Jack Kruse of Glassboro State College captured his third New Jersey State College Conference individual cross-country championship yesterday with a time of 24:47 over the five-mile course.

Derrick Adamson, also of Glassboro State, ran second in 25:28, and Steve Wynne of Trenton State was third at 25:54. Glassboro State, which has won 28 straight dual meets dating back to 1974, placed eight runners among the top 13 finishers.
