Old Tappan girls, Mahwah's Leavesley take second places

HOLMDEL — Old Tappan coach Bruce Hyde wishes the cross-country season was one week longer. If it was, the Golden Knights might be the New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association girls champions.

Old Tappan, getting better every week, finished second to Hunterdon Central, the State leader all season, by 11 points yesterday in the state Meet of Champions. The Knights, paced by Debbie Meberg, running 11th in her final race, put six runners ahead of Hunterdon Central's fifth, but Hunterdon Central's first four runners beat their Old Tappan

counterparts by margins of five to nine seconds, providing the margin of victory.

Meberg finished six seconds behind HC's first finisher, Lori Butterfield, and Megan Murtaugh and Sue Ellen McSweeney were five seconds behind Hunterdon Central's Cricket Batz and Liese Schaff. Colleen Dunn was the fourth OT finisher, in 28th, nine seconds behind Sandy Guidotti of Hunterdon Central. Eugenia Koykas (43) and Linda Rahal (47) also finished in the top 50 for Old Tappan.

Violetta Josevska of Garfield was sixth for the highest individual finish. "I was in a race for second almost all the way, but some of the other girls outkicked me," she said. Ann Gladu won the race in 18:17.6, more than a minute ahead of Terry Gschwind of Summit.

Mary Ellen McGowan of Pascack Valley was ninth, and Carol Dickstein of Ridgewood 18th, leading the Maroons to eighth place. Ridgewood was hampered by the subpar showing of freshman Mary Ellen Mileski, who could manage only 62nd.

Ian Leavesley of Mahwah was the bright spot in a dismal boys showing, finishing a strong third behind winner Jim Smith of Haddonfield and runner-up Kevin Lundy of Long Branch. Christian Brothers Academy, as expected, won the race easily.

Leavesley, who ran 16:21 on the three-mile, Holmdel County Park course was pleased with his performance. "I had a

terrific start and I was with the leaders for the first 1½ miles," he said, "but when they broke away, I was running by myself and the wind made things difficult."

Queen of Peace was the top team finisher in 10th, but the Queensmen were dealt a stunning blow Friday, when No. 2 runner Mark Mallea was seriously injured in a head-on collision in Kearny. Mallea, who is in fair condition in West Hudson Hospital in Kearny, suffered a concussion, and a serious hand injury that required surgery.

Bergen Catholic's Sean Gormley was 14th and Passaic's only entry, Ed Kuri of Passaic Valley was 30th.

Old Tappan's John Nelson, still suffering the effects of a week-long illness, finished 25th after being second in last week's Group 3 race.
