Maroon girls tough in track again

RIDGEWOOD — Coach Jacob Brown apparently has another girls track powerhouse at Ridgewood High.

Despite the torrential rains last Saturday, the Lady Maroons won five of 10 events in the Ridgewood Invitational Relays to runaway

with its third large-school title in the five-year history of the meet.

Eight veterans are back from last year's undefeated squad and all had a hand in the rout at Paramus Catholic's track. In all, eight runners won two events each as Ridgewood compiled 51.3 to handily outdistance runner-up Red Bank Catholic, which had 24.

Senior Norine D'Arcy, the team's top distance runner, logged a 2.25 split on the lead-off leg of the winning 4x800 relay team; junior Jennifer Hughes posted a 5:22 for 1,600 meters in anchoring the victorious 6,400-meter unit; and Ginny Figlar clocked a

2:21 for the 800-meter leg of the winning sprint medley relay.

Jacobs credits these "mid-season-form" splits to a "fine indoor track season" by all three girls. Their efforts earned them All-Suburban honors for the winter campaign.

D'Arcy also ran the lead-off leg for the 6,400 team. Veteran Lynne Collazzo, a sophomore 800-meter specialist, ran legs for both the 3,200-meter and distance medley winning teams; junior letter earner Lynn Degelman for the sprint medley and intermediate hurdles units; and sophomore veteran Jean Hughes for the 6,400 and 3,200 relay teams.

Senior returnee Sheila Vaughn and junior Amy Donnelly were the other members of the winning hurdles team.

Jennifer McDermott, a sophomore longer jumper, is the other veteran back.—ROBERTS

State Quality Running For Girls Track

The girls track team, coached by Mr. Jacob Brown, is perhaps one of the best teams ever assembled here at RHS. According to Mr. Brown, "We have a more balanced team than last year and depth in every area. I am confident that we will do better in a global sense [on the state level] than last year, but we will still be involved in a dogfight with Teaneck, a perennial local foe." Mr. Brown is not, by any means, comparing this year's team to a pushover team last year. "Last year, we were undefeated in our duel meets and won the league meet, making us League Champs. We were also County Relay Champs and finished

second to Teaneck in the County Meet of Champs."

The team is anchored by a solid nucleus of distance runners. Senior Norine D'Arcy leads the way, followed by juniors Jen Hughes and Karen Cannon, and sophomores Jean Hughes and Lynne Collazo. "The distances are the strength of our team," said Mr. Brown. "They're just running awesome in practice right now."


The team is also strong in the sprinting department. "We have one of the better sprinters in the state in Ginny Figlar. Lynn Degelmann, Sheila Vaughan and newcomer Keri Riley are going to help a great deal."

The high, triple, and long jumps are comprised of a group of underclassmen: sophomore Jen McDermott, junior Sheryl Vanderschyff,

and Jen Wrubel. A duet of underclassmen share the bill for the shotput, discus, and javelin. Mr. Brown said, "The weights are an area we need to see action from this season. Tammy Rayevich and Alfreda Eldridge are seasoned veterans, but there's a new kid on the block that can help out in several areas."

That "new kid" is senior Deanie Barth, a softball player turned sprinter and thrower. "Deanie is a good athlete," said Mr. Brown. "She can help us a great deal in the short sprints [100m and 200m] and in the shot, discus, and javelin."

The girls track team seems to have both the talent and the depth in each event to be not only a formidable opponent to other county teams, but teams throughout the state as well.

Day of reign for Ridgewood and Westwood

PARAMUS — Being stuck in torrential rains didn't make for many happy people at yesterday's Ridgewood Relays. But there were at least two smiles when the day had finally finished at Paramus Catholic High School.

GIRLS TRACK

Ridgewood coach Jacob Brown proudly watched his team easily win its third large-school title in the meet's five-year history, and rookie coach Jeff Weiss was more than pleased to see his Westwood squad retain its small-school championship.

Ridgewood was thoroughly impressive, winning five of the 10 events and a share of a sixth on its way to 51.3 points. Red Bank Catholic was a distant second with 24, and Trenton Central took third as about half of the expected 30 teams showed up.

"I was very pleased," Brown said. "Despite the time of year and the weather, we were hitting splits that I wouldn't have expected us to be reaching until late May. There's no question that it's the result of a fine indoor track season."

Brown made specific mention of three runners. Senior Norine D'Arcy posted a 2:25 split on the first leg of the victorious 4 x 800 relay. Junior Jen Hughes ran a 5:22 in anchoring the winning 4 x 1,600 event. Junior Ginny Figlar

went 2:21 in running the 800-meter leg of the sprint medley relay.

Trenton Central won all three of the sprint relays, with Ridgewood twice taking second. The high jump, the only field event, ended in a three-way tie between Ridgewood, Monroe-Woodbury, and South Shore. In all, Ridgewood had eight runners win two events each.


WESTWOOD'S victory was centered on a smaller nucleus, yet the Cardinals were able to win six of the 10 events, finishing with 41 points. Shoreham Wading River took second with 24 points, and 22 points earned Fonda a third-place finish.

Leading the Cardinals were juniors Maureen Grabley and Maggie Rodgers, who were each part of three victorious relays. Juniors Mary Sok, Stacey Price, Laura Gavigan, and Christine Brown each won two events.

"We don't have a great deal of depth, but the people we do have are quality, experienced runners who didn't let the weather bother them," Weiss said. "I thought we would fare very well, and it certainly is a great way to start the season."

Three of the teams Weiss said he was expected trouble from — Passaic Valley, New Milford, and Midland Park — were among about half of the scheduled 30 teams that stayed home.

Pequannock captured the high jump, which was held in the Paramus Catholic gymnasium. Linda Mann and Sue Lynch each

cleared 5 feet, and Lori Mulqueen went 4-9 for the Panthers.

"I was pretty confident we would take this event," Pequannock coach Rich Mullins said. "The same three girls have combined to win the high-jump relay here the past two years, and it's a shame that the rest of the horizontal jumps were canceled because I'm sure Linda, Sue, and Lori would have fared well."

The only other field event of the day was the shot put, and that was just for the small schools because water had engulfed the ring by the afternoon session. Westwood won the event, with Stacey Price making a toss of 31-7 in leading the team of three to a combined toss of 87-9.



Ridgewood survives surprises

PARAMUS — Abandoned by his boss, who left town for an early vacation, assistant coach Dave Ascietto was left to oversee the Pascack Valley girls track team at the Bulldog Relays at Bergen Community College. All in all, he said, he could have done without the confusion, although he was prepared to live with the final, established order.

"I think this is going to get us ready for the teeth of our schedule," said Ascietto, whose team finished third yesterday overall in the girls meet. "We scored in eight of the 15 relays. I'll take that."

As expected, Ridgewood took the title, but not easily. The Maroons barely beat Tottenville of Staten Island, 42-40. With the outcome dependent on the final 4 X 400 re-

lay, Ridgewood got an outstanding final leg from Ginny Figlar, who turned in a 59.4 performance to seal the win.

GIRLS TRACK

The Maroons, who last week won the Ridgewood Relays for the third time in five years, scored in almost every event. Coach Jacob Brown was especially encouraged by the showing by his sprinters, including Lynne Collazo, Jean Hughes, and Noreen D'Arcy.

But it was Pascack Valley's effort that impressed several coaches at the meet. The Indians, who have in recent years labored without success to finish above .500, kept Ascietto busy picking up medals.

Kim Baumbach was the key to getting Pascack Valley past many

of its opponents yesterday. The senior anchored the two-mile relay team that finished a surprising third and got off several important jumps to help the Indians take the triple and long jumps.

Pascack Valley's inspired effort earned it a slight advantage over rival Old Tappan, which finished with 28 points, one behind the Indians.

"They are a very good team in big meets," Old Tappan coach Therese Smith said of the Indians.

Smith was pleased by the shot put relay effort turned in by Jeanine DeSocio and Cindi Rupp, both of whom threw over 30 feet for the first time to give the Golden Knights a second-place finish.

Bergenfield, which took second in the 110 shuttle hurdles, also captured the shot put, helping gain a sixth-place finish overall.

Brown's return lifts Highlands

Ramsey wins
team crown

PARAMUS — Minutes after completing his second mile of the day, Jeff Brown stood on the infield of the Bergen Community College track late yesterday afternoon, sweat pouring off his face, his chest heaving. He did not, however, appear to be in pain. Asked about his condition, the Northern Highlands distance runner smiled quickly, saying he was satisfied that he was breathing at all.

"I'm lucky," said Brown, who has twice undergone extensive surgery in the last year to repair his sinuses. "I always believed I would run again some day, but I had some questions about this season."

Brown answered some of those questions yesterday, running the mile in 4 minutes 24 seconds to help the Highlanders break a 25-

year-old school record in the four-mile relay at the Bulldog Relays. His second mile, run in 4:36, was good enough to carry the Highlands distance medley relay team to a second-place finish.

Ramsey, without an outright victory in any event, captured team honors, with 24½ points.

BOYS TRACK

The Rams received solid performances from John Collins in the pole vault, and Lee Oelkers and Matt Fialko in the jumps. Two Ramsey field events competitors, Andy Pero and Tom Eilers, placed in the shot put, discus, and javelin competition.

Brown, however, was the star of the meet.

"He looked just terrific," said Northern Highlands coach Bob Hillenbrand, whose team tied for third behind Ramsey and Christian Brothers Academy of Albany, N.Y.

"It's quite a story."

The story began last year when Brown, who ran a 4:20 mile — the second-fastest in the state — fin-

ished a workout complaining of headaches. Soon he could not move his head at all, and after an examination, doctors operated.

"Getting back in shape has been hell," said the senior. "Every step you took, you wanted to quit. I still don't have the conditioning to run two really good races in a day." And his teammates didn't have the heart to commit themselves to the indoor and cross-country season this winter without Brown. "When I left, they didn't practice, didn't want to," said Brown, who will attend William & Mary next fall on a track scholarship. "I don't think they thought they could win without me."

Other local teams turning in strong performances were Don Bosco and Bergen Catholic.

Don Bosco received a surprising first-place finish in the long jump as Derrick Horner and Rob Moseley combined to jump 39 feet 11½ inches. The Ironmen, though, were hurt later in the meet by the loss of Horner, who pulled a muscle in the sprints.

Bergen Catholic, which sent a

small contingent to the meet, received a personal best performance from senior John Wohner in the pole vault. Wohner, who cleared 13 feet, combined with Gerry Maron to vault 25-6 and win the event.

IN OTHER BOYS MEETS, Saddle Brook took first place at the Rutherford-Lyndhurst Relays, topping New Milford, 48½-31½. Vic Van Dyke, Tony Primavera, Nick Joannidis, and Tony Bolognini won the 4 X 800 relay in 8:55.8. In the mile relay, Joannidis and Bolognini teamed with Carl Hans and Rick Wisse to run away with the event in 19:52.9. Chi Chen and Scott Zottollo captured another event for the Falcons when they combined for a distance of 39-2½ in the long jump.

Westwood girls are favored

Although early-season relays don't always indicate who'll win at the Jack Yockers Bergen County Relays, it's unlikely that a dark horse will emerge at this weekend's annual event.


By that standard, Westwood's and Ridgewood's girls should be heavily favored in the 1-2 and 3-4 championships, respectively, as should Saddle Brook's boys in Group 1-2. But strange things can happen in the two-day meet, which begins this afternoon with the small schools at the New Milford track and the large schools at Hackensack, both at 3:30 p.m. The meet concludes Saturday at 8 a.m. in Hackensack.

In the girls 1-2 meet, Westwood's sprint and weights power looks too strong for the rest of the division, and the Cardinals should handily repeat last year's win.

In 3-4, Ridgewood, off consecutive wins in the Ridgewood and Bulldog Relays, should ride its distance power and all-around excellence to its sixth consecutive win, perhaps with a score approaching last year's record 53 points. But a fine Teaneck team, which finished second at the High Point relays, will challenge. If Teaneck can beat Pascack Valley's jumpers and can get some help in the sprints, the Highwaywomen could win its first title since 1980.

Saddle Brook, heavily favored in last year's 1-2 event, failed to show in time for the shuttle hurdles last year and ended up losing to Waldwick. This year, the Falcons should win. Look for New Milford, Rutherford, Mahwah, and Waldwick to contend.

In 3-4, Ramsey won last week's Bulldog Relays and Demarest the small-school Ridgewood Relays, but look for the champion here to come from Bergen Catholic, Ridgewood, and defending champ Hackensack.

Collazo paces Ridgewood; Westwood wins Group 1-2

TENAFLY — The last time Jasmin Jones sat on Lynn Collazo's shoulder, the Ridgewood sophomore crumbled, barely managing to collect enough of herself to finish the race. Yesterday, there were 200 yards to go in the sprint medley at the Jack Yockers Bergen County Relays when the Hackensack star again appeared on Collazo's shoulder.

This time, she simply got dusted off.

"I knew she was coming," Collazo said of Jones, who had caught and then buried her on the final leg of the sprint medley at the county indoor relays last February. "But I didn't want to let myself be chased by her. I really didn't want to think about her at all."

So she blocked her out and then closed the door. Running the 800-meter anchor leg for the Maroons, Collazo turned in a personal best when she outran Jones down the stretch. The win helped spark Ridgewood to its sixth straight girls team title for large schools, 53-43 over Teaneck, which finished second for the third straight year. Pascack Valley took third, seven points behind the Highwaywomen.

Westwood got strong field performances from Stacey Price and Debbie Pickens and standout track times from Aquansa Garth and Mary Sok to win the team championship for small schools. The Cardinals outscored New Milford 49½-44½. Saddle Brook was 15 points back for third.

Jones, who nonetheless ran a 2:11 800 and a 4:56 mile during the day, was given the Jacob Brown Award as the outstanding track performer.

"We knew Jasmin was going to catch Lynn," Ridgewood coach Jacob Brown said of his emerging

sophomore. "I just told Lynn to try and stay with her, not to concede. Frankly, I didn't think Lynn would hold her off."

After the race, Collazo made no attempt to hold back her emotions, calling her sub 2:18 performance the race of her life.

Teaneck lost all chance to be a serious threat to Ridgewood when its shuttle hurdles team was disqualified.

"When you start the day like that, it kind of shakes you," Teaneck coach Cheryl Miller-Porter said.

The Ridgewood squad was always steady, sometimes spectacular throughout the day, setting three meet records in the distance events. Collazo, Jean Hughes, Jennifer Hughes, and Norine D'Arcy finished the 3,200 in 9:37.9. In the 6,400, the Hughes sisters teamed with Karen Cannon and Nanci Titus to win in 21:37.8. Collazo and D'Arcy later combined with Ginny Figlar and Lynn Degelmann to win the 1,600 in 4:02.7.

Teaneck's Becky Miller, Ann Wellington, and Cheryl Cole together threw the discus 267 feet 2 inches to capture that event. The Highwaywomen also finished first in the 400-meter relay when Missy Hicks, Toya Williams, Shonna Clay, and Pam Birchett turned in a time of 52 seconds.

Senior Kim Baumbach, named the winner of the Dick Hitt Award as the outstanding field events performer, led Pascack Valley to a victory in the long jump, combining with Chris Bella and Lauren Traphagen to leap 43-10½. The Indians also took the javelin when Diane Drago, Kathleen Applin, and Lori Mererg threw a combined 252-4.

Garth, Sok, and Keirsten Wallace led Westwood to victories in all three sprint events, setting meet records in the 400 and 1,600.

Lisa and Lynn Petrolia and Kim Taylor paced New Milford, teaming to win the long jump (41-7½) and shuttle hurdles (1:11.1).

Ridgewood sweeps to twin victories

MONTCLAIR — There was a role reversal behind Ridgewood's two team victories at the Northern New Jersey Interscholastic League Bergen division meet yesterday at Woodman Field.

The boys, with a star-laden lineup of seniors, got some fine performances from their stars, but also got some outstanding work from sophomores Craig Halyard and Kevin McCabe and junior Eric Ellinghaus to edge Hackensack, 69-66.

The girls, with a mostly underclass lineup, needed an inspiring performance from senior Norine D'Arcy to edge Teaneck, 87-83, for their first league meet title in four years.

And Hackensack's Jasmin Jones set a county record in the 400, just missed a second record in the 3,200, and won her specialty, the 800, in the third fastest time in the United States this season.

Ridgewood's boys came out of Friday's first half of the meet trailing Hackensack 36-28, but Maroon coach Dick Van Yperen was confident that his team could come back and win.

"If we just continued to do what we had done Friday, I thought we would win," said Van Yperen. "And we continued to score well."

A 1-3-4 finish in the 800, keyed by Chris Rae's meet-record 1:54.5 (sixth all-time in Bergen), and a 1-2-3 finish in the 1,600, with Rae, 3,200 winner Eric Berntsen, and McCabe running under 4:29, were the primary elements in the win. But Van Yperen saw even more good signs.

"It has been a struggle to get these kids to think team, because the natural choice in track is to go for the individual performances," Van Yperen said. "But the way we ran the mile (1,600) was a team race, with every one helping each other out. And that was the way we dealt with this day."

Halyard, who won the triple

jump with a leap of 45-5½ (fifth-longest ever) Friday, came back to win the long jump at 21-5 to clinch the meet in the day's final event. Doug Shultz won the 400 intermediates and took a second and a fourth. Ellinghaus had a surprise fifth in the 400 to help the Maroons to the win. Berntsen's 9:21.6 in the 3,200 set the second meet record.

Ridgewood's girls win came as a surprise to Jacob Brown, who thought that Teaneck might be too strong for the Maroons.

"But we had a mistake-free meet," said Brown, "And when Norine won that 1,600 for us after running as well as she did yesterday [Friday], it inspired us."

D'Arcy won the 1,600 yesterday in 5:08.0, running down Amy Kempf of Paramus in the final straightaway. She had also finished third in the 3,200 in 10:58.6 Friday, in a race in which the first

four finishers moved into the Bergen top 10. She helped Ridgewood outscore Teaneck, 26-1, in the three distance events, overcoming Teaneck's 34-13 advantage in the sprints and high hurdles.

"This sets us up for what we can do as a team," said Brown. "Had we lost badly, we might have just concentrated on some individual goals."

Jones took 0.6 off her own 400 county record in defeating Ginny Figlar of Ridgewood in 56.2. She also won the 800 in 2:11.8, less than 1½ seconds from the national high school lead and had won the 3,200 in 10:36.5 Friday, only two seconds from the county record.

Teaneck was paced by Pam Birchett, who won the long and triple jumps, the latter with a jump of 36-2½, seventh longest in county history. Teaneck took seven first places to just three for Ridgewood.

Ridgewood, NM run off with titles

HACKENSACK — Like the eternal chicken-egg question, the debate has long raged in northern New Jersey: Who has the better girls track team? Ridgewood or Teaneck?

After yesterday's near-record display of 55½ points, the Maroons get the nod. Ridgewood defeated defending champion Teaneck for its fourth New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association North Jersey Section 1, Group 4 championship in five years.

The Highwaymen finished with 50½ points, and Passaic and Hackensack tied for a distant third with 20 points apiece.

GIRLS TRACK

New Milford edged Midland Park, 44-39, for the Group 1 title, its third straight, in another close event.

"It always comes down to us and Teaneck," Ridgewood coach Jacob Brown said. "It looked like a county meet out there, we were both scoring so many points. I had envisioned a lot lower score, but maybe we and Teaneck are better than we thought."

Eastside, considered to have an outside shot at the title along with Passaic, totaled just 16 points — all by Sharon Allen.

Ridgewood fell half a point short of tying the sectional record for most points scored by a team, 56, set by Teaneck in 1979 — and did so with only one individual winner. Ginny Figlar ran a 58.1 400-meter run to edge Teaneck's Lauren Singleton, and the Maroons' 1,600-meter relay team outraced the Highwaymen by more than six seconds to capture top honors.

Teaneck, competing without top sprinter Missy Hicks and discus-shot putter Anne Wellington, won four events, including a double by Shonna Clay in the 100 and 200.

The Maroons led by 10 points entering the final event, the high jump, and would have been tied by Teaneck if they hadn't placed a jumper and if the Highwaywomen had finished 1-2.

Teaneck did its part, taking first and second, but Ridgewood's Jen Wrubel had other ideas. She jumped 5-0 to tie Deb McDonald for second place.

Norine D'Arcy also picked up crucial points for the Maroons, taking seconds in the 3,200- and 1,600-meter runs. Jennifer Hughes added a third in the 1,600.

Christensen triumphs at girls meet

TENAFLY — A specialist in the shot put and discus, Kirstine Christensen usually competes in the shadow of the track stars, her achievements buried in the next day's sports sections.

"Nobody besides the field events people even know who I am," said the accomplished senior. "I've often thought about quitting."

TRACK

To the dismay of her Bergen County rivals, Christensen has never followed through on such thoughts. Instead, she keeps piling up victories. Yesterday, Christensen — who has not been beaten in the shot put in two years — won the shot put and discus events at the ninth annual Bergen County Girls Meet of Champions at Tenafly Junior High School.

"After a while, you ask yourself, Why do it, why put in the time?" said Christensen, who is the defending state outdoor champion and current state indoor champion in the shot put. "You end up doing it for yourself. I'd rather be behind the stage in the theater, but I wouldn't mind some notice for what I do at these meets."

What she did yesterday was throw the shot more than 40 feet five times, including her winning toss of 41 feet, 5½ inches. After fouling several times in the discus and down to her final throw, she produced the winning effort of 114-5.

In the same meet, Jasmin Jones of Hackensack turned in the fastest 800-meter time in the country this year, completing the two laps in 2 minutes, 9.9 seconds.

"I'm impressed with the time, but I was hoping for better," said Jones, who ran alone for much of the final lap. "I got too relaxed on the final straight. Maybe if there was somebody with me, I could have gone faster."

Kim Baumbach had enough trouble figuring out where to go next. Shuttling back and forth between the jump pit and the track, the Pascack Valley senior

mann won the intermediate hurdles in 63.7, Norine D'Arcy claimed the mile in 5:06.8, and four Maroons teamed to take the mile relay in 4:06.2.

Dawn Reis of Lodi was victorious in the high jump, clearing 5-2. Elena Primero won the javelin with a personal best throw of 124-5.

CHRIS RAE of Ridgewood captured the Eastern States Championship in the 1,600 meters Monday at St. John's University. The senior distance runner cut three seconds off his previous best to win in 4:13.6, the fastest time in the state this year.
