Not necessarily coming from behind to capture victories, although both Diana Lawson of Queen of Peace and John O'Neill of Ridgewood did that in winning events. But comebacks of all sorts.

For Lawson, it was a comeback to the form that made her one of the top freshman in North Jersey last indoor season, and a comeback to track after skipping last spring.

For O'Neill, it was a comeback after a disappointing ending to his 1997 cross-country season with an eye toward wiping out his injury-riddled junior year.

And for Vicky Byrne of Saddle Brook, it marked a comeback from a stunning 800-meter loss two weeks ago and a return to the form that earned her a State Group 1 outdoor championship two years ago.

Lawson won the girls 400 in 62.3 seconds, defeating Janna Kohout of Glen Rock with a sensational finish after Kohout had opened a big lead.

"I didn't want to let her get further away from me and I tried to get her in the first turn [on the final lap], but it took longer than I expected before I caught her," said Lawson, who pulled away in the final straightaway to win by five yards.

"I always wanted to run indoors, and I want to support the team, but it was too much for me to run outdoors last year," said Lawson, who was second team in both the 300 and 400 last winter. "I still don't know what I'm going to do this spring, but I'm happy I'm running now."

For O'Neill, who led the Maroons to a stunning upset in the Group 4 sectional cross-country championships last fall, but missed a spot in the State Meet of Champions with a subpar Group 4 State this fall, his come-from-behind victory over nemesis Tom Baldwin of Hackensack, his second such win in two weeks, boosted his confidence for what he hopes will be a terrific senior year.

"I just felt I had a good kick in the end left tonight." said O'Neill, who allowed the race to go through

finishing strong to to win in 2:44.9, five yards ahead of Corey Kunz of St. Joseph Regional, with Baldwin fading to third. "I was disappointed that we didn't do better in cross-country with it being Mr. [Larry] Coyle's last year, but I'm glad my confidence is back in the indoor season. Tom and I talk to each other a lot about what we're going to do and I felt I could outkick him tonight."

But perhaps the most stunning turnaround came from Byrne, who skipped last indoor season and then was upset by Clifton's Natalie Popowicz in the Season Opener 800 after building a 25-yard lead with a lap to go.

"I learned a great lesson the other night," said Byrne, who won the 600 in a great early season time of 1:43.7 with a 30-yard margin. "I can't worry about what other people say or do. I just have to have faith in my workouts and realize that if I work hard at them, I'll be able to run my race."

Other winners Tuesday included Kawesi Darby of Hackensack in the boys 55 meter, Mike Stansfield of Garfield in the high hurdles, Jarrett Jackson of Passaic Tech in the 400, and Chris Chioffe of Glen Rock in the 600.

Carlene Cummings of Englewood swept the girls 55 and high hurdles as usual, continuing her impressive improvement in the latter event, and Bergen cross-country champ Celeste Sedo of Ridgewood made her indoor debut in the 1,000, edging teammate Meg McDermott.

The most impressive relay win of the night went to a surprising Snyder team, which ran the fifth fastest girls .3,200 relay ever at Rothman, 10:06.9 to edge Ridgewood, which ran the sixth fastest time of 10:09.6. Hackensack won both boys relays and the girls 1,600.

HACKENSACK - Team championships are few and far between during the winter track sea-

Apparently, when the Hackensack boys and girls smell a title. they are ready to find another spot in the crowded Comet trophy case.

Westwood rules Group 1 relays

Westwood won its first-ever State track championship Sunday at the New Jersey State Interscholastic Athletic Association Relays at Jadwin Gym, when the boys, winning three of seven events, defeated Pleasantville and Arts, 35-24, for the Group 1 title.

It was the second State title of the school year for Westwood, which won the Group 2 girls volleyball championship in the fall.

Seniors John Demarest, Andrew Giannotti, and Matt Caporaletti were part of the winning Westwood distance medley and 3,200-meter teams, and the Cardinals also won the shot put.

"I first thought of this as a goal as I was driving to the Atlanta Olympics in 1996," said Westwood coach Steve Lurie. "I thought we were ready to win it last year, but Metuchen just killed us."

Westwood opened by winning the distance medley in 10:59.02, topping Pope John by 60 meters. Demarest ran the 1,200-meter leg and handed off to Doug Salvi, who ran a personal-best 400-meter leg. But the Cardinals were still fifth as Salvi handed to Giannotti.

Giannotti ran 2:00.2 for 800 meters and handed off to Caporaletti, the anchor with a lead. Caporaletti had little trouble holding the lead, running 4:33.4 for 1,600 meters.

Westwood was sixth in the shuttle hurdles, retaining its lead, but slipped to third when Arts and Pleasantville went one-two in the 800 relay. The Cardinals were fourth in the high jump and closed to within three points of Arts and Pleasantville.

The Cardinals then earned their second win and took the lead for good when Demarest, Caporaletti, Giannotti, and rapidly improving junior Michael Dopf set a group record of 8:19.93 to win the 3,200 meters by 30 meters over Science.

Moments later, when Bryan Sheldon and Mike Stankowitz completed their win in the shot put, the Cardinals had clinched the title before the final event.

'Stankowitz really has only thrown three times since his soph-

NEW YORK — A team built on wo or three top athletes won't win he Bergen County Indoor Relays.

That was made evident Thursay night, when the Don Bosco rep and Westwood boys and the lidgewood and Westwood girls saily won titles at the 168th treet Armory Track Center.

Don Bosco perhaps was the tost impressive of the four team inners as 14 different athletes tared in five titles and a 78-56-54 in over Hackensack and Ridgeood in the Boys A Division.

"We scored in every event, even field events where I thought we ad no chance of scoring," Bosco each Bill Barry said. "We had so any personal records, I couldn't lieve it. Everyone just perrmed so well."

Each of the other team champis had at least three gold medals, but only four of Bosco's 14 ld medalists managed two golds.

The Ironmen set a school record 18:22.7 in winning the meet's st event, the 6,400-meter relay, sich was paced by Dan Conras' 4:28.9 leg. They also won

the sprint medley, distance medley, 3,200, and pole vault.

"Our kids just performed so well," said Barry, who returned to the track after a month away because of personal business. "We knew we'd be very good in the distance events, but we were also third in the long jump and fourth in the triple jump with near [personal records]. And we even got a fifth in the high jump and shot put."

Ridgewood's girls were the easiest winners, winning seven of 11 events and placing in the top three in all but one event en route to a 93-46-45 victory over Hackensack and Bergenfield in the A Division.

It wasn't surprising that Celeste Sedo anchored the 6,400-meter relay team to a win with a 5:14 leg or that the Maroons also won the sprint and distance medleys with Meg McDermott, voted the Lou Molino Most Valuable Performer, running significant legs.

But their wins in the 800, 1,600 and long and triple jumps were a surprise to many. But not to their head coach.

"I wasn't really surprised how the sprinters and jumpers did," Ridgewood coach Mike Mullen said. "I thought with the training we've done that they would shine at the end of the season when the championships came around, and they did."

Helena LaMothe and Lizzie Vogelbach were the day's only winners of four gold medals, combining to win the long jump and aiding in the 800 and sprint medley wins.

"Helena's triple jump was a PR, and Lizzie gave us some good anchor legs in both the 800 and 1,600 relays," Mullen said.

Westwood's victories were similarly propelled.

The boys won their fourth straight B title, 84-42, over River Dell, winning eight of the 10 events they entered, while the girls won or finished second in eight events in an 83-59 win over defending champ Dumont.

"We performed very well in almost every event we were in," boys coach Steve Lurie said. "We were especially good in the field events. We expected to do well, because a trio like Neal Okarter, Gareth Hedges, and Bryan Sheldon makes any team good in the field."

Okarter, the Alan Wedemeier Award winner for outstanding male performer, leaped a stateleading 45 feet seven inches to team with Sheldon in the triple jump, jumped 20-8 to team with Hedges in the winning long jump, and ran a leg on the sprint medley team, anchored by Andrew Giannotti in 1:57.9.

Sheldon and Hedges combined to win the high jump, and Sheldon also led Westwood to a shot put win.

The trio of Jenica Asadorian, Nicole Stinson, and Crystal Oliver were triple gold medalists to lead the girls.

"Jenica anchored three wins for us, and we added a lot of depth in every event," coach George Glover said. "We have a lot of really good kids who really care about each other. The new outdoor track at our school has helped us do well."

Janelle McCollum, who helped the Cardinals win the 1,600 and distance medley, will move to Teaneck next week and made her final appearance with Westwood a successful one."

"We'll miss her a lot, and we wish her a lot of luck at Teaneck," Glover said. "She really helped us win this title."

Emerging from the shadows

night at the Bergen County Indoor
Relays at the 168th Street Armory
Track Center in New York.

The two athletes share more than the plaques in common. Both have performed in the shadow of better-known athletes and now are claiming their own share of the spotlight.

For McDermott, winner of the Lou Molino Award, named in honor of the longtime outdoor Bergen County meet director and successful coach and athletic director at Ramsey, it was another step toward her own recognition apart from more celebrated teammates Kelly Behan and Celeste Sedo.

"I was totally shocked by the award," said McDermott, who led off the winning 6,400 relay with a good 5:25.2 leg, anchored the 3,200 relay to second in 2:27.1 for 800 meters, and ran an excellent 4:03.9 leadoff 1,200 leg in the winning distance medley. "I had a good day, but I think it could have been better, but I never expected this."

McDermott, who helped the Maroons to the Bergen County cross-country title and second in the State in her first year of cross-country and was All-Bergen in the 1,000 meters last winter, expected that Thursday would be an important night for her.

"I came in here today totally psyched up," said the exuberant junior. "I knew I was going to anchor the 4 by 8 and wanted to get us going in the 4 by 16 and the distance medley. It's great for our team to win."

Okarter, who shared indoor all-Bergen triple jump honors last win"It's two totally different events, one of technique and one of explosion," said Okarter, who earned the Alan Wedemeier Award named in honor the former Waldwick All-Bergen star who died while acting as a good Samaritan two years ago.

Okarter jumped a state-leading 45-7 in the triple and added a near PR of 20-8 in the long jump to propel Westwood to dominant wins in both events. He also ran a 200 leg on Westwood's winning sprint medley.

"The team comes first as long as I jump for Westwood," said Okarter, who despite his own success has performed in the shadow of fellow seniors Andrew Giannotti and Matt Caporaletti, who have starred in cross-country as well as indoor and outdoor track. "I was happy with my long jump, but still felt I could have done a better job with my jump into the pit in the triple jump."

"Playing football this year really helped me stay confident and get stronger," said Okarter, whose return to the gridiron helped the Cardinals into the Group 2 finals. "I'm still operating off a football high."

"I wasn't out of touch because [acting coach] John Neapolitan faxes me all of our results and we talked every other day on the phone," said Barry, whose team dominated the Boys A competition. "You don't want to see my phone bill. He and Mark Fabish and Sean Durkin, our other assistants, just did a great job and I can't say enough about the work they did with the kids.

"We did a lot of planning on the phone, even as far as the workouts went. But the personal touch is important and they were just so good with the kids, it set us up for this great performance."

NEW YORK - Probably the two most honored coed track and field programs in Northern New Jersey over the last two decades are at Hackensack and Ridgewood.

So it's not surprising that the Comets and Maroons swept divisional titles Monday night at the fourth Northern New Jersey Interscholastic League Indoor Championships at the Armory Track and Field Center.

Hackensack won its fourth straight Pacific Division boys title, 135.5-111, over Don Bosco, on the strength of a 51-6 margin in the 55- and 300-meter sprints. The Comets won their fourth straight girls title, 137-117, over surprising Immaculate Heart Academy, despite a sensational triple by IHA freshman Courtney Cubicotti.

The Ridgewood girls team won its third title in four years, 137-81, over defending champion Eastside, scoring 100 points in the 1,000, 1,600, 3,200, 3,200 relay, and triple jump. The Ghosts managed mly 11 points in the five events. The Ridgewood boys won their first title, 142-99, over defending champion Montclair, earning five vins and six seconds in the 14 vents.

Assistant coach Dave Petrella of Hackensack wasn't surprised by he Comets' comeback from losing ooth ends of the Bergen Relays on Thursday night.

55 and 300, keying a 1-2-3-6 finish in the 55 and 1-2-3-5 in the 300. Baseball convert Mike Beebe had a personal-best 50-foot throw to win the shot, while the 1,600 relay ran 3:29.2, the best time in Bergen County this year.

But the standout individual in the division was St. Joseph Regional's Corey Kunz, who easily won the 1,000 in 2:36.3 and then kicked beautifully to take nearly 10 seconds off the 1,600 meet record.

"I was really surprised to run as well as I did in the 1,600," said Kunz, a junior. "I thought I'd lose touch earlier in the race. It's the first time I've beaten Tom [Baldwin] and Dan [Contreras] on the track.

'She flies," said IHA head coach Charlotte LoSchiavo. "She continues to astound me and in the

Buraick, Cummings lead area at SMOC

PRINCETON — Three years ago, Carlene Cummings of Englewood tried hurdling for the first time. She ran up to the first hurdle and jumped high over it, then did that at each of the remaining barriers on the track. She was a sprinter who ran the hurdles for extra practice and little else.

In December, Cheryl Burdick agreed with Ramsey coach John Kirchof that it might help her in the spring if she high-jumped in the Colgate Women's Games in the winter. The State meet wasn't even on

her agenda.

Sunday, the one-time novice hurdler and the part-time winter high jumper each added a title in front of her name:

New Jersey State champion.

Cummings, despite a slip near the finish and despite hitting the second of five hurdles, won the 55-meter hurdles, while Burdick cleared 5 feet, 8 inches on her final attempt to win the high jump at the New Jersey State Meet of Champions.

Six other Bergen-Passaic athletes earned seven other medals at the meet, with Westwood's Andrew Giannotti getting edged at the finish of the boys 800 and Ridgewood's Celeste Sedo winning a pair of medals.

But it was Cummings and Burdick who headed the local contingent.

Cummings led the qualifying round with a personal best of 8.16 seconds, but Sherese Price of Pleasantville, her closest

rival, was looming behind her.

"I hit the second hurdle, which threw me off, then I almost slipped right at the finish," said Cummings, who still won with a personal best of 8.11, tying for ninth on the alltime New Jersey list. Quite a change from the hurdler of three years ago.

"I was so scared when I started hurdling, because I was afraid of hitting my knees on the hurdles, that I jumped over the hurdles, I didn't hurdle them," said Cummings. "I got better the next two years, but this year I wanted to focus on being a good hurdler and not just someone fast who hurdled."

Burdick needed a friendly crossbar on her final attempt at 5-8 to edge Kristin Composto of JFK-Iselin for her gold medgen record-setting 5-8/2] and 1 really wanted to make it again."

Burdick grazed the bar with her foot. It wobbled as she fell into the pit but refused to fall off, giving Burdick her victory.

"That's so much fun," Burdick said after the competition. "This is so much more than I expected when I started this season. I wasn't even sure I would jump indoors. If you told me when I started that this would happen, I wouldn't have believed it. Now I'm ready for anything."

Giannotti's narrow loss to Joe Lewis of Pleasantville for the second straight week

was easier to take.

This time, with the help of Plainfield's Safar Wells, Giannotti took the race out quickly, going through the 400 in 55 seconds, much faster than last week's Group 1 800.

Giannotti took the lead just after the bell for the final 200-meter lap. Later he said he felt it was too soon.

"I moved a little too early," he said. "If I waited until midway in the first turn, I think I could have held Lewis off,"

But despite opening a three-meter lead, Giannotti felt Lewis coming. With about five meters to go, Lewis drew alongside and just beat Giannotti to the tape, 1:56.13-1:56.32.

Giannotti was still pleased with his performance.

"This is almost as fast as I ran last year outdoors," said Giannotti, whose time was fourth-fastest in Bergen indoor history. "I'm excited about the spring season."

Sedo finished third in the 1,600 in 5:13.22 and fourth in the 3,200 in 11:11.57. Both times are top-10 alltime Bergen performances.

"I'm not breathing hard, but my lungs hurt," said Sedo, running her first indoor season. "I'm glad I did it, but this indoor stuff isn't easy."

junior won his first two varsity medals.

Steve Adams, track coach at Old Tappan High School who officiated at the Manhattan event, watched in awe as Strahle administered mouth-tomouth resuscitation.

"I said, 'Holy cow!' The kid had stopped breathing, and because of what she did, I could actually see him start breathing again," Adams said.

That Strahle later that day threw her best shot put ever paled next to saving a life.

"I said to her, 'Your night is made. You already did the best thing anyone could ever do.'" Adams said.

Before Feb. 2, Strahle and Santivanez didn't know each other. He emigrated from Bolivia two years ago with his mother. On that Sunday at the 168th Street Armory, Strahle didn't even see him fall. The first thing that alerted her to trouble was a moan.

Turning around, she saw Santivanez lying on the track with a half-dozen people gathered around him. "I thought he had hurt his leg or sprained something," she recalled.

She ran to see if she could help — a typical reaction for Strahle. "She's a great kid, really caring," said Mike Mullin, her coach. "She's always upbeat and the kind of person who would do anything for anybody."

When she got to the felled runner, a Hackensack teammate, Eric Beebe, was giving Santivanez chest compressions. The youth didn't seem

to be breathing, and people didn't know exactly how to help.

Strahle was practiced in CPR, even though she had trained only on mannequins. A lifeguard the past few summers, Strahle has had to be recertified in CPR each year. But the campers she supervises at Camp Nyoda in Oak Ridge are pretty good swimmers. "I've never had to use my CPR training," she said. "I've never saved a life."

The first thing Strahle did for Santivanez was take his pulse. He had one, so she told his teammate to stop the chest compressions. Then she brushed near his nose and mouth to see if he was breathing. He wasn't. There was blood on his head, and his mouth was filled with foam

"I was very nervous," she said.
"I wondered if I could remember how to do it. I thought. Is this even going to work? So I went through the motions, praying it would, and hoping the paramedics would come soon."

Strahle cupped her mouth over his and started giving short breaths. Soon his chest started to rise. But Strahle's feeling of relief was short-lived. After about 30 seconds, Santivanez started having seizures.

Luckily there was a doctor in the crowd, and he ran to take over. Meanwhile, David Petrella, assistant coach at Hackensack High School, ran to Columbia Presbyterian Hospital, directly across the street from the armory. Parame-

dics there ran back to the armory and carried Santivanez to the hospital.

Strahle began to shake. "I couldn't believe what happened, and that I had done what I did," she said.

She took that nervous energy back to the track circle and added about a foot to her shot put. That evening at home, she told her parents what happened. "My mom was in tears," she said. Strahle couldn't sleep that night as she replayed the day's event in her head. The next couple of days, the kids at school called her a hero.

Santivanez underwent tests and was released the next day. He apparently overheated and fainted, hitting his head on the iron barrier. But tests showed he was fine—so fine that he was back running the next week. On Feb. 16, he earned two medals.

At a meet last week. Santivanez

walked up to Strahle to thank her.

"He kept saying, 'Thank you, thank you,'" she said. "I was surprised. I thought I would never hear from him again."

Strahle said she learned something about herself.

"I learned that under a stressful situation, I used my head, thought clearly, did what needed to be done, and did it quickly," she said. "I had never been tested before."
